PARID Membership Information

Voting Members

Certified Member: Any interpreter or transliterator of American Sign Language and/or English currently holding a valid certification from RID, Inc. This membership can be under any certified category defined by RID, Inc.

Associate Member: Any individual who is actively engaged in the interpretation of American Sign Language and English and/or the transliteration of English, but who is not currently certified by the RID, Inc. Individual must be a member of RID, Inc. This membership can be under any category defined by RID, Inc.

Non-Voting Members

Student Member: Any individual currently enrolled in a course of study in interpretation of American Sign Language and English and the transliteration of English, who does not meet eligibility requirements under Certified or Associate Membership.

Supporting Member: Any individual with an interest in supporting the purposes and activities of the organization, who does not meet eligibility requirements for Certified, Associate, or Student Membership.

Organizational Member: Any organization/institution with an interest in supporting the purposes and activities of PARID.

Membership

Membership may be obtained upon application to the PARID Board.

Good Standing

A member organization or individual in good standing is one whose dues are not delinquent. Member organizations or individuals whose dues are in arrears for 90 days shall be dropped from the membership roll.

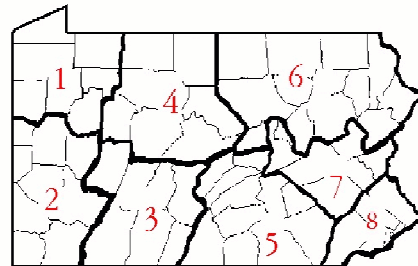
Change of Membership Category

A member who has a change of membership category shall immediately be entitled to the privileges thereof. Beginning with the next fiscal year, all dues, fees, and assessments for that member shall be based on the new category.
