## PARID Membership Information

### Voting Members

**Certified Member:** Any interpreter or transliterator of American Sign Language and/or English currently holding a valid certification accepted by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf, Inc. (RID).

**Associate Member:** Any individual who is actively engaged in the interpretation of American Sign Language and English and/or the transliteration of English, but who does not hold valid certification accepted by the RID.

### Non-Voting Members

**Student Member:** Any individual currently enrolled in a course of study in interpretation of American Sign Language and English and the transliteration of English, who does not meet eligibility requirements under Certified or Associate membership.

**Supporting Member:** Any individual with an interest in supporting the purposes and activities of the organization, who does not meet eligibility requirements under Certified, Associate, or Student membership.

**Organizational Member:** Any organization/institution with an interest in supporting the purposes and activities of PARID.

### Membership

Membership may be obtained upon application to the PARID Board of Directors.

### Good Standing

A member organization or individual in good standing is one whose dues are not delinquent. Dues shall be paid by July first (1<sup>st</sup>). Members whose dues are not renewed by August first (1<sup>st</sup>) shall be dropped from the membership roll.

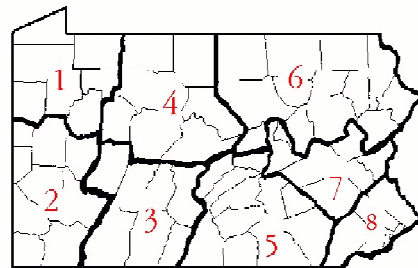
### Change of Membership Category
